【Independent Study Example】

Learning to work diligently and methodically

- Enhance understanding through reviewing class notes, handouts, textbooks, and resource books. Improve reading comprehension and retention by extracting key points.
- Review questions that were answered incorrectly on the test and practice similar ones for further improvement.
- Practice Kanji daily to reinforce learning and actively use the characters you've learned in your daily life.
- In social studies, locate places on a map when mentioned, and understand historical events by examining timelines and explaining in your own words.

Learning to incorporate what you've learned, your interests and concern

- Apply what you've learned in home economics to daily life, challenge yourself in cooking or sewing tasks.
- Engage in cultural learning through activities like music appreciation and reading.
- In Physical Education, explore sports of personal interest both through research and personal participation.
- Develop a habit of relating what you've learned to current events, reflecting on your own thoughts, and discussing them with family and friends.

Learning to be independent and persistent through critical thinking

- Research class questions using textbooks, references, and the internet.
- Progress to challenging application problems in math after mastering the basics.
- Create sentences using English vocabulary and phrases learned.
- Reflect on artwork worldviews and merits using art textbooks, forming personal perspectives.
- Understand science experiment results by thinking and explaining why they occur.
