


Towards Home Study Improvement [Elementary School]

[Independent Study Example]

Learning to work diligently and methodically

- Repeat and practice Kanjis and calculations. (Using drills and flash cards etc.)
- Read aloud with clarity and coherence.
- Locate prefectures on a map and write their names in Kanji.
- Reflect on lessons and summarize key terms and content.

Learning to incorporate what you've learned, your interests and concerns

- Create and solve math word problems, and present them to family members.
- Summarize personal opinions on local news topics and listen to family members' opinions.
- Apply what you've learned in home economics and discuss observations with family members.

Learning to be independent and persistent through critical thinking

- Find areas for improvement and practice for better presentations.
- Work on similar problems to those answered incorrectly and jot down key points for future attention.
- Preview relevant sections in the textbook for the next day's lesson content.
